In Theory courses Continuous Evaluation carries 30% weightage and Term-end Examination carries 70% weightage respectively.

>>>>> MINIMUM STANDARD FOR SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A COURSE AND PROGRAMME <<<<<

Minimum 35% marks for Continuous evaluation and 35% for Term end examination are required with overall 35% marks. 96 credits are required to qualify for the award of Bachelor's Degree in Arts. Student should earn 24 credits of Foundation Courses, 56/64 Credits of Elective Courses and 8/16 credits of Application Oriented Courses. And 48 credits in a particular discipline out of total 96 credits to get Major Degree.
